Such practices resonate with the advertising techniques and formats developed in the modern era, or indeed in the webpage design of today, with obvious implications especially for the broadcast media. These technical advances are not neutral, however, and so we hope to elicit discussion of the extent to which change in the media landscape accommodates or fosters certain ideological positions.
